Sub:- RMSA – Inservice Teacher Training programme for the year 2016-17- Conduct of Summer Residential Teacher Training- District level- Orders-Issued- Regarding.

Read:- Guidelines and Instructions prepared by the SCERT.

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All the District Educational Officers & Ex-Officio Project Coordinators of RMSA in the State are informed that as directed by the Hon'ble Minister for MHRD & Secretary to School Education, the Commissioner of School Education and Ex-Officio Project Director, RMSA-AP, Ibrahimpatnam, Amaravathi has proposed to conduct the Summer Residential Teacher Training Programme for the year 2016-17. The Instructions , guidelines and action plan prepared by the Director, SCERT are enclosed herewith . The key action points are:

- i. There will be summer residential training Programmes covering 8th , 9th & 10th class subject teachers. The training programme will cover Teachers working under all schools categories of Govt. management. Management wise Teachers to be trained are:
- ii. Training will be for 8 days including 05 days subject, 01 day Inclusive Education, 02 days ICT (01 day for PETs).
- iii. DEO shall coordinate with all other managements, appoint Divisional Course Director & Course Coordinators for each Venue & closely monitor conduct of the training programme.
- iv. The training will be in 02 medium.
Telugu medium: Teachers of all Govt, ZPHS & Aided schools.
English medium: Teachers of Model Schools, Muncipla, all residential schools, APREIS & KGBVs.
- v. Proper facilities should be ensured at the Training venues. Biometric attendance of trainees & Recourse persons twice a day should be ensured.
- vi. CSE, SCERT team, Director, RMSA, RJDSE, DEO should visit the training centres and review with the trainees on the quality & effectiveness of training programme.
- vii. Earned Leave will be preserved as per the ruling 15 under FR 82.
- viii. Subject wise Teachers to be trained, District wise are at Annexure I &

II.

- ix. The DEOs are further requested to identify the teachers who have already undergone the 05 days subject teacher training during the 2016-17, they need not again considered for this training. However, they shall be allowed to attend the 01+02 days i.e., 01 days Inclusive Education training and 02 days ICT training . The DEOs should ensure that no teacher can be identified/ trained for twice.
- x. The modules of Telugu, English, Hindi & Social; Studies are supplied to the schools. They should be used in Training Programmes. If necessary, the DEOs should print the required no.of modules and provide to the teachers who attend the training programme and meet the expenditure from the available amounts.

The required funds for teacher Training will be provided by RMSA. The unspent balances already available in the Districts and with the Director, SCERT in the Training component should be spent. Further, the following amounts are being released to conduct of Summer Residential Teacher Training for the year 2016-17 duly deducting the amounts of unspent balances available with DEOs and SCERT.
